

Title: Apostolic Church History

Course Description:

This course will include a historical account of the birth and development of the Apostolic Church established by Jesus Christ, in Jerusalem, on the Day of Pentecost.

The students will understand that the New Testament Church, born in the upper room, has never ceased to exist since its' inception, nor has it been contaminated by the false doctrine of other world religions. It is as pure today as it ever was and will remain so until Jesus comes.

During this course of study we will trace Judaic-Christian religious history from AD33 through the present day. We will explore its' conception, its' growth and development, its' persecution and its endurance to this present day.

In this study of the Oneness Apostolic Church students will explore the tenets of the "New Covenant Church." They will examine the Apostolic Doctrine of Monotheism which has set the "Oneness Pentecostals" apart from the rest of the "Christian Church World."

Finally, through this study we will become acquainted with significant people, events, movements and developments in the history of the Pentecostal Apostolic Oneness Church which began in Acts 2:38..
